ANNUAL REPORT: 2024-2025

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Established in 2018, the Government College for Women, Shahzadpur is affiliated with Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra which is a NAAC accredited A+ grade university. The college is situated at the border of Haryana which is adjacent to Himachal and is thus quite near to the majestic Himalayas. The clean air, greenery, and rustic environs around the college provide a pleasant change that can be felt by any newcomer. The college boasts of a spacious building and is well equipped with modern infrastructural facilities to cater to the needs of girl students from rural areas as well as the staff. The college is spread over 09 acres of land and is specially designed by keeping in mind the needs of differently-abled persons and has ramps and washrooms suitable for them. It has twenty-one spacious classrooms, one conference hall, a well-furnished and newly Air-Conditioned library, and seven functional laboratories belonging to Computer Science, Language, Psychology, Geography, Physics, and Chemistry. The college has ample space for sports-ground, has a mini gymnasium, a common room, and soon to be fully ready multi-purpose hall, well-maintained parks, RO water facility, separate and clean toilets for girls and staff on every floor, parking areas for vehicles (separate for students), a college canteen, a well-furnished and ventilated staff-room and departmental rooms. All these are essential parts of the basic infrastructure which make the process of education pleasant and endearing. As per the university and Haryana Govt. orders, the college has implemented National Education Policy 2020 for both at the Undergraduate level, and the Post-Graduate level. The College runs three regular streams-Humanities, Sciences (Non-Med & Comp. Sci.), and Commerce. It offers a choice of eleven subjects for the students of Humanities; General Course for the students of Commerce; and four subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and Computer Science for Bachelor of Physical Sciences. At the postgraduate level, the college has a Master in Commerce which commenced in 2022. Presently a total number of 610 girl students are studying here and four batches of the students have already graduated from college.

A dedicated and diligent team of teaching and non-teaching staff (Twenty-eight teaching, twelve non-teaching (regular and contractual) and five members under NAPS) perform their duties under the competent guidance of the Principal. The collective efforts have ensured regular classes for students and have brought laurels to the College in both academic and non-academic fields.

The College, being a government institute, receives several Annual Grants-in-Aid such as a Library Grant, Passport Grant, Women Cell Grant, Road Safety Grant, Augmentation of Laboratories, Earn-While-You-Learn, Assistance for science Exhibition, Placement Cell, etc. for different activities and purposes. During the session 2023-2024, the college has utilized approximately 3,47,93,285/- rupees worth of grants and in the ongoing session this figure is 3,75,06,407/- rupees.

The institute aims to empower girl students not only in academics way but also aspires their overall grooming. The college has the privilege of bagging many prizes at District, Zonal and Divisional Levels.

Though a new college, the college is the first one to upload All India Survey on Higher Education (AISHE) data on the MHRD portal. The college has been registered with NAAC and SHREYAS (Scheme for Higher Education Youth for Apprenticeship and Skills). The Internal Quality Assurance Cell regularly conducts meetings and takes steps to ensure requisite quality standards.

The collective vision of the college is to create a generation with good moral values, high cultural values, and a continuing tradition of students who take pride in being Indian; students and teachers who are committed to and can learn and align these qualities with the changing world to have a successful future. This is also reflected by the motto of the college: श्रद्धावान लभते ज्ञानं.
