

# **Report**

## **Day 1: Inauguration and Team Building**

The 7-day NSS camp began with a formal inauguration ceremony, where Dr. Kashmir Singh, Principal of the college, highlighted the importance of social service and community engagement. The volunteers participated in ice-breaking sessions and team-building activities. All volunteers were distributed into 5 teams, and duties were allotted to them for the seven-day camp. The day concluded with a motivational lecture on the role of youth in nation-building, a poster-making competition among the 5 teams, and ended with the NSS song.

## **Day 2: Health Awareness and Stress Management**

The second day began with yoga and NSS drill. A team from the Community Health Center conducted health check-ups, and Ms. Monika CHO and Ms. Sudesh Counselor delivered lectures on healthy lifestyle and stress management. Mr. Kapil from WHO TB Alert India, along with TB Champion Sukhpal, shared knowledge on TB symptoms, prevention, and cure. The day ended with a slogan-writing competition on drug addiction and digital literacy.

## **Day 3: Cyber Crime Awareness and Street Play Competition**

The third day began with yoga and NSS drill. Dr. Nisha, Assistant Professor in Commerce from Govt. College Naraingarh, delivered a lecture on "Cyber Crime and its Psychological Effects". A street play competition was organized on social issues such as cybercrime, drug abuse, and cleanliness.

## **Day 4: Financial Literacy and Drug Abuse Awareness**

The fourth day began with yoga and NSS drill. Dr. Ashu, Assistant Professor in Commerce, delivered a lecture on "Financial Literacy" and informed the volunteers about various government schemes. Dr. Vanita, Assistant Professor, delivered a lecture on "Drug Abuse: A Silent Killer". In the afternoon, a rally was organized in Badagarh village, and two best

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street plays were performed in the nearby village to create awareness about drug abuse and cleanliness.

#### **Day 5: Artificial Intelligence and Peace and Harmony**

The fifth day began with yoga and NSS drill. Dr. Priyanka Gupta, Assistant Professor, Government College Madlauda, Panipat, delivered a lecture on "Artificial Intelligence: Benefits and Drawbacks". A lecture on peace and harmony was delivered by Anil Kumar Raj, representative of Vidya Kendra and Youth Peace Foundation. After lunch, a 1-2 minute video competition was organized to create awareness about NSS.

#### **Day 6: First Aid Training and Tree Plantation**

The sixth day began with yoga and NSS drill. First Aid Trainer Ravindra Kumar provided training to the volunteers on first aid in emergency situations. Dr. Anand Kumar, NSS Coordinator, Kurukshetra University, interacted with the volunteers and inspected the camp. He planted a tree in the college campus and assigned the responsibility of taking care of it to the first-year volunteers for the next two years. Dr. Anand Kumar distributed plants to the volunteers and instructed them to plant a tree in their neighborhood and take care of it throughout their lives. A lecture was delivered by Rajbir Singh Sandhu on habits that can change life.

#### **Day 7: Valedictory Function\***

The 7th day of the NSS camp began with a warm welcome to Dr. Pawan Saini, former MLA of Haryana. He addressed the volunteers, emphasizing their capabilities to upgrade society and the importance of the NSS motto. A cultural program followed, and the best volunteer, Mannat, and winning team, Team B, were announced. 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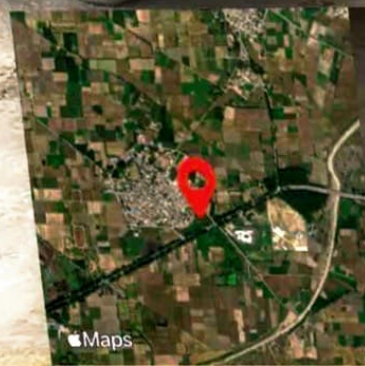




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# एनएसएस शिविर में विद्यार्थियों ने नुक्कड़ नाटक का किया मंचन

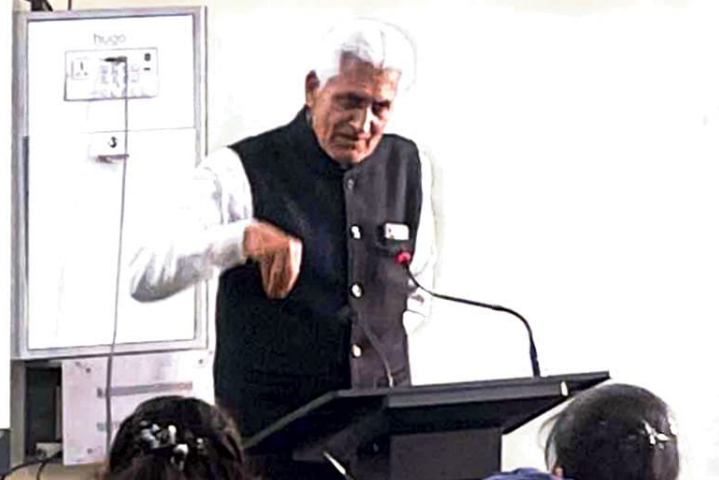
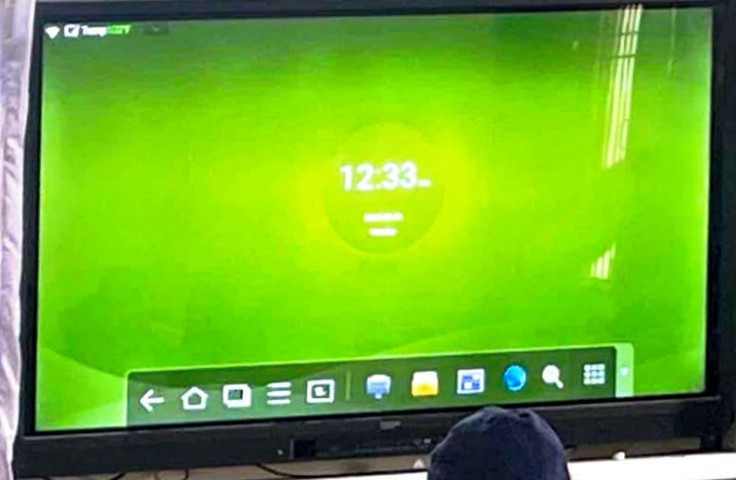
# एनएसएस शिविर में मानवता और शांति पर व्याख्यान, एआई के फायदे-नुकसान भी बताए

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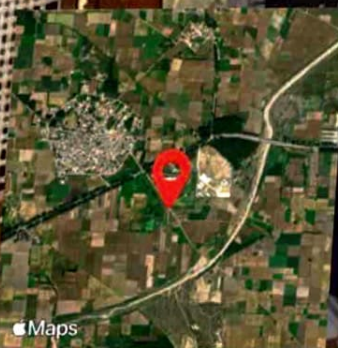


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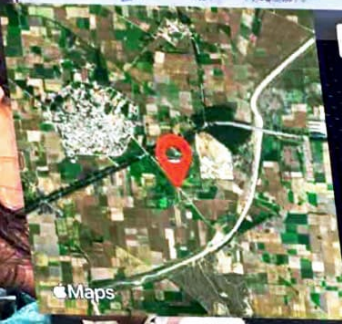
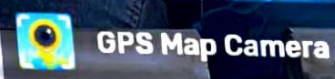
