

## **Govt. College for Women , Shahzadpur**

### **Annual Report 2018-19**

Established in 2018, Govt College for Women, Shahzadpur is affiliated to KUK. With a sprawling campus of 09 acres, the college is surrounded by hills and greenery which provides a visual feast. Presently being run in Senior Secondary Govt. School, Shahzadpur, College boasts of a spacious building having more than 20 class rooms, various labs, multipurpose hall, cafeteria and other facilities. In this Session College has a total admission of 129 girls. It is at present running BA I and BCom I with various subjects. It proposes to start BSc and other short term courses in next session. The institute aims to empower girl students not only in academic way but also targets their overall grooming. The college has the privilege of bagging many prizes at District, Zonal and Divisional Level.

Though new college, still the college is first one to upload AISHE data on MHRD portal. College has been registered with NAAC and SHREYAS (Scheme for Higher Education Youth for Apprenticeship and Skills). The IQAC has been formed and a meeting has already been held.

Our Vision is to create a generation with good moral values, high cultural values, who takes pride for being Indian; able to learn and align these qualities with the changing world to have a successful future; following our logo **श्रद्धावान लभते ज्ञानं**.

Our Mission is to impart quality education to develop lawful, balanced citizens with humanistic approach, who can serve nation and globe with their analytical knowledge and multi-skilled personality.

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College was inaugurated by State Minister Shri Naib Singh Saini on 26.7.2018. After performing “Hawan”, staff members along with MLA and other Guests reached new college building (under construction) for tree plantation.

### **Inter College Participation**

1. Our students participated in “National Level Exhibition – Mathematics at Work” organized by Maths Dept of SD College (Lahore) Ambala Cantt on 23<sup>rd</sup> Oct, 2018.
2. Students participated in Zonal Youth Festival at GC Kalka from 11-13 Oct, 2018 and obtained third position in the On the Spot Painting and Poster Making. Our college was the only rural college to have bagged prizes in Youth Festival.
3. Our students participated and were selected for District Level Competition in National Youth Parliament at M.M. University, Mullana, Ambala.
4. Our students participated in 6 items including Quiz Competition and Slogan Writing at District Level organized by Legal Literacy Cell of Govt College, Ambala Cantt and won third prize in Quiz Competition and Slogan Writing. Our students participated in Quiz Competition and Slogan Writing at Divisional Level organized by Legal Literacy Cell of Govt College, Ambala Cantt and won third prize in Quiz competition. Students participated in Quiz Competition at State Level organized by Legal Literacy Cell of Govt College, Sec 1, Panchkula also.
5. Seven girls of the college attended KUK, Kurukshetra sponsored literary workshop at MN College, Shahbad from 1-3 March. The students attended lectures on interview skills, Radio Announcing, Civil Exams and Environment.

### **Scholarship:**

1. 53 SC girl students have been awarded Rs 12000 as scholarship. Rs 2000 has been allocated for purchasing the books. 20 BC girl students have already applied online for Rs 3000 per head scholarship. 10 meritorious students have been approved for scholarships.

### **College Activities (Cultural and Literary)**

1. An orientation programme was conducted on 20.7.2019 to make students aware about the college and various cells/committees were constituted in the college for the welfare of students. Students were made aware about university and college rules.
2. An International Youth Day was celebrated in college campus on 14.8.2018. The Principal addressed the students and told them about the role of youth in the progress of nation.
3. Independence Day was celebrated in the college campus on 15.8.2018. National Flag was unfurled and various cultural programmes were presented by the students.

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4. An assembly was conducted to mourn the death of our former Prime Minister, Mr. Atal Bihari Vajpayee on 18.8.2018. In his memory, various poems were recited.
5. A cleanliness drive was also carried out in the college under the “Sawach Bharat Abhiyan” on 18.8.2018

1. On the occasion of Dhyan Chand’s birthday, the college organized the National Sports Day on 29.8.2018. Students participated in various sports events.
2. A Sports Meet was organized in the college which included various sports events on 15.1.2019.

**Red Cross:**

1. Our Girls attended Road Safety function at Traffic police Station Shahzadpur, on 4.1.2019. Mrs. Aastha Modi, IPS graced the occasion as the chief guest: girls and faculty interacted with the young Police Officer.

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2. Students participated in a Five Day District Level Red Cross Camp organized by District Red Cross Society at GMN College, Ambala Cantt. One of our students was awarded for special performance during the camp.
3. Road Safety Week was observed in the college 27.2.2019. Various competitions like Slogan Writing, Poster Making, Speech Competition were conducted. A rally was organized to create awareness about road safety.

**Electoral Club:**

1. National Voter's Day was observed in the college on 21.10.2018 to make girls aware of our Electoral System. Rajan Singla, BDPO was the chief guest. Students were imparted knowledge about EVM machine and election process.

Rally was conducted to spread the cause of women safety. An extension lecture was given by Mrs. Madhu, (Counsellor) on Women Empowerment. The Principal answered the queries regarding problems faced by women in the society. Students took a pledge for women safety by tying a "Sankalp Sutra" to the trees.
3. A lecture on sanitation for girls was delivered by Shiwani Verma on 1.9.2018, Mrs. India 2018 (Parivartan NGO) which was sponsored by NGO, Parivartan. Students were shown a play to create awareness among students about sanitation.
4. An awareness programme and Health Camp was organized in the college, by NGO Family Planning Association of India; . Mr. Manish Garg, Manager, Family Planning Association of India on 21.9.2018, Panchkula Branch, was the chief guest. He imparted knowledge regarding Reproductive and Sexual Health. Programme Officer, Mrs. Sonia Arora, imparted knowledge regarding adolescence problems.
5. National Youth Day was celebrated in the college in collaboration with Family Planning Association of India on 10.1.2019. A speech competition was organized. Mrs. Anita Batra,
